This program encourages open communication about some common ongoing social struggles and concerns (including peer pressure, oral sex, and pornography) that are faced by the youth of the nation on a daily basis. This program also gives insight on ways to help others avoid becoming victims by explaining how your actions, words, and choices affect others.

Personal Safety & Human Trafficking Awareness For Kids: 3rd-6th Grade & A Guardian



“Stranger Danger” no longer applies because facts prove that most abuse happens at the hand of someone the victim knows and trusts. Prevention through awareness is the key.

Warning Lights Kids gives an overview of age-appropriate personal safety skills that are pertinent to be a kid in today’s society. This session discusses lures that are specifically used to entice kids, explains the signs and provides ways to respond to human trafficking. This program will give your audience of both kids and their guardian (guardian attendance required) a stronger sense of how to protect themselves and others. This program encourages open communication and arms you with a variety of methods to make these safety tactics a habit for your family. This program also gives insight on ways to help others avoid becoming victims by explaining how your actions, words, and choices affect others.

Warning Lights (in partnership with Created Free) are collaborating to reach more women who are currently employed by the sex industry. Our partnership gives us a combined level of experience that is more than a decade. By offering various resources, as well as guidance to safe, healthy, and happy futures, our elite volunteer teams bravely reach women in local strip clubs and other illicit establishments. We have witnessed tremendous relationships form and grow in our efforts to fight human trafficking. Our nonjudgmental approach has allowed us to turn strangers into friends while empowering women to live in freedom.



ALTOGETHER BEAUTIFUL

It is well known in our fight that in order to enable women to heal from sexual and emotional trauma, we must allow them to escape their situation to find refuge, comfort, and safety.

This is exactly what the *Altogether Beautiful* program does. We are eager to take our relationships to the next level by meeting more frequently with women outside of the various illicit establishments.

Our annual goal is to raise \$10,000 for this program. We estimate that each event will cost approximately \$2,500, based on our ability to invite 50 women and, occasionally, their families. This total cost per event covers the venue, rentals, invitations, food and desserts, decor, gifts, and activities.
